On the Subject

At the latest since 2010 various stakeholders are actively engaged in the public debate on the future course of the European Agricultural Policy. The Chair for Economic Development and Integration, the Wilhelm Merton-Centre for European Integration and International Economic Order and the Institute for Rural Development Research at the Johann Wolfgang Goethe University Frankfurt/Main are holding an international conference on the future design of the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP).

The following objectives are being pursued:

- **Critical analysis of the European Commission's proposals with regard to the future of direct payments, market measures and rural development policy instruments.**
- **Identification of possible compromises, but also unbridgeable differences, between the various stakeholders at the national and international level as a contribution to the political opinion making process.**

In the morning of the **conference** the results of a study on the public debate on the future CAP, which was carried out in ten European countries, will be presented, put into the context of the latest political developments and discussed with the participants.

Representatives of different political levels will comment on the results.

In the afternoon the participants will deal with some of the most controversially debated elements of the reform proposals in moderated working groups. A special focus will lie on the exchange of perspectives between the different EU member states.

Rapporteurs will present the results of the working groups in the closing plenary session.

The **opening event** the evening before will, after a speech, offer the opportunity to get to know the international participants and informal exchange of ideas.
